SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 894, L.D. 2299, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Legislative Confirmation Hearings"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the first paragraph in the
4th line from the end (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out
the following: "45" and inserting in its place the following: '30'


Further amend the bill in section 1 in the first paragraph
in the last line (page 1, line 19 in L.D.) by inserting after the
following: "Representatives" the following: 'except that
hearings on judicial nominations and Workers' Compensation
Commission nominations must be held by the joint standing
committee having jurisdiction over judiciary matters within 35
days of the Governor's written notice'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in the first paragraph
in the 6th line (page 1, line 29 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "20" and inserting in its place the following: '15'
