HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1645, L.D. 2308, Bill, "An Act to Establish the Motor Vehicle Emission Inspection Program"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~S2402.~~" by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'1. Requirement. After July 1, 1994, each motor vehicle registered in the State must be inspected biennially for air pollution emissions as provided in this chapter and have a valid certificate of compliance or waiver before a motor vehicle safety inspection, required under Title 29, section 2502, may be conducted.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill establishes a Motor Vehicle Emission Inspection Program. The emissions inspection fees and inspection station license fees will increase dedicated revenue by approximately \$5,730,000 annually beginning in fiscal year 1993-94. The Department of Environmental Protection will require allocations of this dedicated revenue beginning in fiscal year 1993-94, approximately \$4,775,000 annually for contractors selected by the department and \$955,000 annually for 6 positions and general operating expenses in the Bureau of Air Quality Control.

The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment makes the biennial air pollution emissions
inspection apply to any motor vehicle registered in the State and
adds a new fiscal note.
