of this dedicated revenue beginning in fiscal year 1993-94, approximately \$3,112,500 annually for contractors selected by the department and \$622,500 annually for 4 positions and general operating expenses in the Bureau of Air Quality Control.

The additional geographic areas required to participate in the program by July 1, 1996 will increase dedicated revenue by an additional \$2,130,000 in fiscal year 1996-97, of which \$355,000 will go to the Department of Environmental Protection and the remaining \$1,775,000 will go to contractors selected by the department.

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The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment makes the biennial air pollution emission inspection applicable after July 1, 1996 to any motor vehicle registered in this State. It also deletes reference to exemption of gross vehicle weight rating of more than 10,000 pounds from the inspection requirement. This amendment replaces the fiscal note to reflect these changes.
