### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2904, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1981, c. 639, §1, is further amended to read:
- 2. Other documents. A gift of any part of the body under section 2902, subsection 1, may be made by document other than a will including a license to operate motor vehicles or motorcycles issued pursuant to Title 29, section 540-C. The gift becomes effective upon the death of the donor and upon acceptance by the donee. The document, which may be a card designed to be carried on the person, must be signed by the donor, in the presence of 2 witnesses who must sign the document in his the donor's presence. If the donor eannet can not sign, the document may be signed for him the donor at his the donor's direction and in his the donor's presence, and in the presence of 2 witnesses who must sign the document in his the donor's presence. Delivery of the document of gift during the donor's lifetime is not necessary to make the gift valid.
  - Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §2906, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1969, c. 193, is amended to read:
  - 2. Revocation. Any Except as provided in subsection 4, any document of gift which that has not been delivered to the donee may be revoked by the donor in the manner set out in subsection 1 or by destruction, cancellation or mutiliation of the document and all executed copies thereof.

### Sec. 3. 22 MRSA §2906, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

- 4. Drivers license. A gift made pursuant to Title 29, section 540-C may be revoked by application for a new license to operate motor vehicles or motorcycles and revocation of the form executed under Title 29, section 540-C, subsection 2 in the manner set out in subsection 1.
- Sec. 4. 29 MRSA §540, as amended by PL 1991, c. 32, §§2 and 3, is further amended to read:

#### \$540. Contents of license

Each license shall <u>must</u> state the name, date of birth, place of residence of the licensee, <u>and</u> permanent number assigned the licensee, and may contain such other information as the Secretary of State deems <u>determines</u> necessary. The license shall <u>must</u> also bear a full-face color photograph of the licensee for the purpose of identification except that those persons who renew their licenses on or after their 65th birthday, persons in active military service stationed outside the State and temporary

licenses issued under section 533 may be exempt from the photograph requirement. A license which that does not contain a photograph of the licensee may be issued as the Secretary of State deems determines necessary, except that the holder of a commercial driver's license shall is not be exempt from the color 6 photograph requirement. 18	4. Effect. A license issued under this section is evidence

22	STATEMENT OF FACT
24	This bill changes the law concerning anatomical gifts. The
26	bill repeals the language under which a person, by placing a sticker on a drivers license, indicates a willingness to make an
28	anatomical gift upon death. Under this bill, any person seeking a drivers license or renewal will be given a form by the
30	Secretary of State by which that person can actually make an effective gift under the Uniform Anatomical Gift Act. If the
32	licensee makes declaration of an anatomical gift on that form, the Secretary of State will issue a license that is color coded
34	to that licensee and include an additional code or notation certifying that such a gift has been made.
