SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 910, L.D. 2330, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Special Commission on Governmental Restructuring"

Amend the amendment on page 6 by inserting after section F-4 the following:

Sec. F-5. 10 MRSA §940, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 875, Pt. K, §1 and affected by §3, is amended to read:

A matching fund, referred to in this chapter as the "fund," is established within the association. The association may use general--revenue funds appropriated--to--the--fund obtained from contracts with departments, divisions or agencies of the State for the purposes set forth under this chapter, provided that the association match every ~~2-General-Fund-dollars~~ \$2 used from the fund with \$1 raised from its private and public members described in section 933. All state contracts must be administered through the Department of Economic and Community Development.

Sec. F-6. 10 MRSA §942, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 875, Pt. K, §1 and affected by §3, is amended to read:


2. **Dissolution of association.** Upon dissolution of the association, the members shall transfer all unexpended ~~General Fund--appropriations--to~~ contract funds from the State before paying or making provision for the payment of all other liabilities of the association.
