HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 911, L.D. 2331, Bill, "An Act to Encourage Private Sector Investment in Tourism"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1825-B, sub-§9 is enacted to read:

9. Prejudice to private enterprises. In making any award for tourism-related services, the State Purchasing Agent shall ensure that the award is not likely to result in a subsidy to the recipient of the contract that prejudices private enterprises engaged in advertising tourism matters.'
