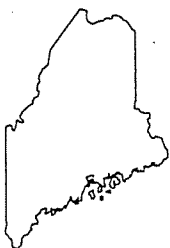

Resolve, to Study Technical Education in Maine Public Secondary Schools.



Sec. 1. State Board of Education to study technical education.

Resolved: That the State Board of Education, with advice and counsel from any public education strategic planning group, shall examine the issue of technical education in secondary schools, including:

1. Options for enhancing current secondary technical education programs;

2. Ways to better coordinate secondary and postsecondary technical education programs; and

3. Ways to make better use of existing secondary technical centers for expanded education opportunities; and be it further

Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the State Board of Education shall report its findings to the Joint Standing Committee on Education and the Office of the Executive Director of the Legislative Council by January 15, 1993. The State Board of Education is not authorized to submit legislation as part of the report.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve is one of the measures submitted by the Special Commission on Governmental Restructuring. The resolve directs the State Board of Education, with advice and counsel from any public education strategic planning groups, to study technical education in the State's secondary schools and report its findings to the Joint Standing Committee on Education.
