24	The estimated cost of sending this resolution out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the Second Regular Session of the 115th
26	Legislature. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional
28	referendum costs an additional \$7,000.
30	If approved by the voters, the reduction of the number of members of the House of Representatives will result in future
32	General Fund savings. The amount of savings will depend on the size of the House of Representatives chosen within the range
34	provided by the constitutional amendment. Based on current cost estimates, the average cost per house member in a first regular
36	session is \$22,860 and the average cost per house member in a second regular session is \$16,555.'
