HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 916, L.D. 2353, Bill, "An Act to Establish a Supervised Community Confinement Program for Certain Prisoners of the Department of Corrections"

Amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "~~§3036-A.~~" in subsection 6 in paragraph A in the 5th line (page 4, line 5 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "and" the following: 'intentionally'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "~~§3036-A.~~" in subsection 6 in paragraph A by striking out all of the last line (page 4, line 9 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'offending activity.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The original bill makes it a crime to interfere with supervised community confinement and provides that one component of that interference is to contribute to the violation of or cause a prisoner to violate the confinement program. This amendment requires that this contribution or cause be intentional.

The original bill makes it a condition of being charged with a crime that the person who is interfering first be warned to cease association with the prisoner. This amendment changes that condition to require that the person be warned to cease the offending activity.
