SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 921, L.D. 2360, Bill, "An Act Regarding Maine's Comprehensive Early Intervention System for Infants and Children under 6 Years of Age"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 3 the following:

Sec. 4. 26 MRSA §962, sub-§7, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 576, is amended to read:

A. Any officer, board, commission, council, committee or other persons or body acting on behalf of:

(1) Any municipality or any subdivision of a municipality;

(2) Any school, water, sewer or other district;

(3) The Maine Turnpike Authority;

(4) ~~The Child Development Services System~~ Any board of directors functioning as a regional intermediate education unit pursuant to Title 20-A, section 7730; or

(5) Any county or subdivision of a county; or'

Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.
