COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1685, L.D. 2365, Bill, "An Act Relating to Gambling"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, section 2 of this Act takes effect when approved and sections 1 and 3 take effect June 30, 1992.

FISCAL NOTE

The additional costs associated with the Chief of State Police issuing special licenses for certain annual raffles with prizes worth between \$10,000 and \$75,000 can be absorbed by the Department of Public Safety within the existing allocated resources. The amount of additional dedicated revenue generated by these special license fees can not be estimated at this time.

Repealing the Maine State Lottery Commission's authority to participate in the Lotto*America game may affect the flexibility of the commission to reenter that game. The effect on future General Fund revenue would be minor.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment delays the effective date of the provisions repealing authority for Lotto*America until June 30, 1992 and adds a fiscal note.
