COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1688, L.D. 2368, Bill, "An Act to Create the Dresden Mills Water District"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the first paragraph in the 7th line from the end (page 1, line 51 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "public municipal" and inserting in its place the following: 'quasi-municipal'

Further amend the bill in section 12 in the first paragraph in the 9th line from the end (page 6, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "without the vote of its inhabitants,"

Further amend the bill in section 13 in the 2nd paragraph in the first line (page 7, line 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "of" and inserting in its place the following: 'by'

Further amend the bill in section 14 in the first paragraph in the 4th line (page 7, line 30 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: ", and" the following: ', except as otherwise expressly provided in this Act,'

Further amend the bill in section 16 in the first paragraph in the 3rd line (page 7, line 45 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "1993." and inserting in its place the following: '1994.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 16 the following:

Sec. 17. Local referendum impact. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 5684, additional

2 costs, if any, imposed on any municipality by the provisions of
this Act providing for a local referendum are not funded by the
4 State.'

6 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

8 **FISCAL NOTE**

10 The Public Utilities Commission will incur some minor
12 additional administrative costs to regulate a new water
district. These costs can be absorbed within the commission's
14 existing budgeted resources.'

16 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

18 This amendment makes technical corrections to the bill. The
20 amendment exempts from the municipal mandate law the referendum
provision of the bill. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
