HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 922, L.D. 2369, Bill, "An Act to Further Enhance and Protect Maine's Great Ponds"

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Amend the amendment in section 22 in subsection 2-A in the first line (page 5, line 32 in amendment) by striking out the following: "<u>1993</u>" and inserting in its place the following: '<u>1994</u>'

## STATEMENT OF FACT

26 This amendment changes the date for the ban on the sale of household laundry detergents containing phosphorus from January 28 1, 1993 to January 1, 1994. This additional time is necessary to enable retail stores and distributors to clear their shelves of 30 existing inventories of laundry detergents containing phosphorus. It will also give manufacturers of the detergents 32 that will be banned more time to reformulate their products if they choose to continue to sell in this State. 34
