HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1693, L.D. 2373, Bill, "An Act Regarding a Piscataqua River Basin Council"

Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of subsection 5 (page 1, lines 29 to 31 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'5. Four elected officials from the Maine seacoast area who represent the towns of Elliot, Kittery, South Berwick and York, appointed by municipal officers of those towns.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the composition of the Piscataqua River Basin Council by requiring 4 elected officials from the affected seacoast area, which includes the Town of York under this amendment.
