HOUSE AMENDMENT 'C' to H.P. 1699, L.D. 2379

This amendment increases certain appropriations allocations to the Department of Human Services, the cost of which is offset by increased health insurance surplus funds (\$206,250) and (\$700,000) in savings from state employee health insurance appropriations in fiscal year 1991-92. The (\$700,000) in General Fund savings must be achieved through the collective б bargaining process prior to May 31, 1992. If the collective 8 bargaining process is not successful, then the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services is authorized to increase 10 the state employees' health insurance contribution rates for the remainder of fiscal year 1991-92 in order to achieve the savings. 12 -

This amendment also freezes state employee merit increases 14 for the period July 1, 1992 to June 30, 1993 only.
