HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 929,
L.D. 2384, Bill, "An Act to Restructure State Government"

16 Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 4th line after the title (page 1, line 20 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of Parts B, 20 C and D.

Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund

\$10,900

Part A of the bill will require a General Fund appropriation to the Legislature of \$10,900 in fiscal year 1991-92 for the per diem and expenses of the Commission on the Reorganization of Health, Social and Developmental Services, which will report out legislation to create 2 new state departments by merging several current departments and agencies. The Legislature can absorb staffing costs during any interim between sessions.

The Department of Human Services and the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation, and the Offices of Substance Abuse and Community Services can absorb the costs of providing information and assistance to the commission within existing budgeted resources.

The Interdepartmental Council will absorb the costs related 8 to a study of juvenile corrections services.

10 It can not be determined if any savings can be achieved through the proposed reorganization.'
