SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P.
929, L.D. 2384, Bill, "An Act to Restructure State Government"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of Part D.

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the
fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

1991-92

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$10,900

Part A of the bill will require a General Fund appropriation
to the Legislature of \$10,900 in fiscal year 1991-92 for the per
diem and expenses of the Commission on the Reorganization of
Health, Social and Developmental Services, which will report out
legislation to create 2 new state departments by merging several
current departments and agencies. The Legislature can absorb
staffing costs during any interim between sessions.

The Department of Human Services, the Department of Mental
Health and Mental Retardation, the Office of Substance Abuse and
the Office of Community Services can absorb the costs of
providing information and assistance to the commission within
existing budgeted resources.

SENATE AMENDMENT

SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 929,
L.D. 2384

2 The Interdepartmental Council will absorb the costs related
to a study of juvenile corrections services.

4 It can not be determined if any savings can be achieved
through the proposed reorganization.

6 The transfer of the Division for the Blind and Visually
8 Impaired within the Department of Human Services to the
Department of Education in Part B of the bill is required to be
10 accomplished with no additional funding.

12 Part C of the bill abolishes the State Planning Office in
fiscal year 1993-94 and establishes a Director of State Planning
14 in the office of the Governor. It can not be determined if there
will be future General Fund savings until the Legislature
16 determines the reassignment of current program components to
other state agencies.'
