STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment creates an Office of Civil and Human Rights within the Attorney General's Office effective January 1, 1993. The Attorney General is directed to submit to the Legislative Council legislation that would transfer the Public Advocate and other client advocacy services within the executive branch to the new bureau.
