'Sec. 4. Criteria for other agencies awarding funds; assistance; report. The Department of Education, in administering bond proceeds for other than municipal infrastructure projects, to the maximum extent possible, shall follow the criteria established for the Department of Economic and Community Development in section 3 in selecting projects to receive funds authorized by this Act. If requested, the Department of Economic and Community Development shall assist those agencies in developing guidelines for project approval.

The Department of Education shall report to the joint standing committee of the 116th Legislature having jurisdiction over economic development matters on the use of bond proceeds for public infrastructure capital improvements. The report must be in writing and submitted by January 1, 1993.'

This bill includes a General Fund appropriation totaling \$923,503 in fiscal year 1992-93 and a Highway Fund allocation of \$446,600 in fiscal year 1992-93. The appropriations and allocations are contingent on the passage of the bond issue to be voted on at a primary election in June 1992.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires that the performance standards required by the Department of Economic and Community Development of municipalities in contracting for the use of funds provided by a bond issue for a capital construction job creation program be required by the Department of Education when contracting with municipalities for the use of such funds. The amendment deletes some agencies that may be awarded bond proceeds and makes reductions in the amount of the bond issue.

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This amendment adds appropriation and allocation sections and a fiscal note. The amendment also clarifies the effective date of the bill.
