SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1708, L.D. 2389

2 This bill includes General Fund appropriations totaling  
 4 \$121,400 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$2,774,853 in fiscal year  
 6 1992-93 and a Highway Fund allocation of \$1,170,400 in fiscal  
 8 year 1992-93. The appropriations and allocations in Part A of  
 10 the bill are contingent on the passage of the bond issues to be  
 12 voted on at a special election on April 14, 1992. The General  
 14 Fund appropriations in Part B to the Secretary of State, \$121,400  
 16 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$500,000 in fiscal year 1992-93 are  
 18 not contingent on the passage of the bond issues. The General  
 20 Fund appropriations for the cost of the special election will be  
 22 required whether or not the bond issues are approved by the  
 24 voters.'


STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This amendment requires that the performance standards  
 20 required by the Department of Economic and Community Development  
 22 of municipalities in contracting for the use of funds provided  
 24 under Part A be required by other agencies contracting with  
 26 municipalities for the use of such funds.

24 This amendment adds appropriation and allocation sections  
 26 and a fiscal note. The amendment also clarifies the effective  
 28 date of the bill.
