Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

**'PART A'**

Further amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 5 in paragraph A in the 2nd line from the end (page 5, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Act" and inserting in its place the following: 'Part'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 5 in paragraph B in the 2nd line (page 5, line 32 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Act" and inserting in its place the following: 'Part'


This bill includes General Fund appropriations totaling \$121,400 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$2,383,693 in fiscal year 1992-93 and a Highway Fund allocation of \$1,078,000 in fiscal year 1992-93. The appropriations and allocations in Part A of the bill are contingent on the passage of the bond issues to be voted on at a special election on April 14, 1992. The General Fund appropriations in Part B to the Secretary of State, \$121,400 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$500,000 in fiscal year 1992-93 are not contingent on the passage of the bond issues. The General Fund appropriations for the cost of the special election will be required whether or not the bond issues are approved by the voters.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires that the performance standards required by the Department of Economic and Community Development of municipalities in contracting for the use of funds provided under Part A be required by other agencies contracting with municipalities for the use of such funds. The amendment deletes some agencies that may be awarded bond proceeds and makes reductions in the amount of the bond issue.

This amendment adds appropriation and allocation sections and a fiscal note. The amendment also clarifies the effective date of the bill.
