The Department of Education, in administering bond proceeds for other than municipal infrastructure projects, to the maximum extent possible, shall follow the criteria established for the Department of Economic and Community Development in section 3 in selecting projects to receive funds authorized by this Part. If requested, the Department of Economic and Community Development shall assist those agencies in developing guidelines for project approval.

20 The Department of Education shall report to the joint standing committee of the 116th Legislature having jurisdiction 22 over economic development matters on the use of bond proceeds for public infrastructure capital improvements. The report must be 24 in writing and submitted by January 1, 1993.'

12 This bill includes General Fund appropriations totaling \$121,400 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$2,383,693 in fiscal year 14 1992-93 and a Highway Fund allocation of \$1,078,000 in fiscal The appropriations and allocations in Part A of year 1992-93. 16 the bill are contingent on the passage of the bond issues to be voted on at a special election on April 14, 1992. The General 18 Fund appropriations in Part B to the Secretary of State, \$121,400 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$500,000 in fiscal year 1992-93 are not contingent on the passage of the bond issues. 20 The General Fund appropriations for the cost of the special election will be required whether or not the bond issues are approved by the 22 voters.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires that the performance standards required by the Department of Economic and Community Development of municipalities in contracting for the use of funds provided under Part A be required by other agencies contracting with 32 municipalities for the use of such funds. The amendment deletes some agencies that may be awarded bond proceeds and makes 34 reductions in the amount of the bond issue.

This amendment adds appropriation and allocation sections and a fiscal note. The amendment also clarifies the effective date of the bill.
