SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to S.P. 935, L.D. 2393, Bill, "An Act to Promote Economic Recovery"

Amend the bill in Part B by adding at the end the following:

Sec. B-4. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides funds for 2 Accountant II positions and related expenses to make determinations related to Maine-based contractors.

SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 935, L.D. 2393

2 Part A of this bill has significant tax implications that
4 represent a major loss of state tax revenue and a considerable
6 increase in the cost of administration to the Bureau of
Taxation. The specific impact of these changes can not be
determined at this time.

8 Part B of the bill will require General Fund appropriations
10 to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services of
\$9,780 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$55,177 in fiscal year 1992-93
12 for the salary fringe benefits and operating expenses of 2
Accountant II positions to make determinations related to
14 Maine-based contractors.

16 The Finance Authority of Maine can absorb the costs
associated with administering the new programs established in
18 Parts C and D of this bill.

20 Part E of the bill will result in minor administrative costs
to the Public Utilities Commission related to adopting rules.
22 These costs can be absorbed within existing resources of the
commission.

24 The Bureau of Banking within the Department of Professional
and Financial Regulation can absorb the costs related to the
26 examination of proposed mergers of financial institutions, the
adoption of rules and other items in Part F of the bill. The
28 department can also conduct the inventory of available financing
in the State as specified in Part G of the bill utilizing
30 existing resources.

32 The Department of Environmental Protection may realize a
34 loss of dedicated revenue to the Maine Environmental Protection
Fund from the extension of permits in Part G of the bill.'
