SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 937, L.D. 2396, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Maine Juvenile Code"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

The additional workload and administrative cost associated with application of the provisions of the Maine Juvenile Code can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the affected state departments.

The Department of Corrections may realize some minor cost savings if a parent or legal guardian pays the medical or other treatment service costs while a juvenile is on probation or on entrustment from the Maine Youth Center. These minor savings do not warrant a General Fund deappropriation.'
