SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1712, L.D. 2397, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Structure and Operation of the Seed Potato Board"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 2 the following:

Sec. 3. 7 MRSA §2103-A, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 336, is repealed.


Sec. 4. 7 MRSA §2103-A, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 336, is amended to read:

6. Repeal. ~~Subsection 4 is repealed January 1, 1994,~~ subsection Subsection 7 is repealed July 1, 1988, and subsection 8 is repealed July 1, 1990.'

Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment repeals the provision of law requiring that only seed potatoes of a variety that has been released to the public may be certified.
