SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.  
1712, L.D. 2397, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Structure and  
Operation of the Seed Potato Board"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the  
following:

'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting  
the following:

'An Act to Repeal the Sunset on Penalties for Violations of  
Pesticide Laws and Clarify the Certification of Seed Potatoes'

Further amend the amendment by striking out everything after  
the title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its  
place the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the  
enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in  
its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §616-A, sub-§10, as enacted by PL 1989, c.  
841, §3, is repealed.'

Sec. 2. 7 MRSA §2103-A, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 336,  
is repealed.

Sec. 3. 7 MRSA §2103-A, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 336,  
is amended to read:


6. Repeal. ~~Subsection--4--is--repealed--January--1,--1994,~~  
subsection Subsection 7 is repealed July 1, 1988, and subsection  
8 is repealed July 1, 1990.'

2 **FISCAL NOTE**

4 The repeal of the sunset on pesticide penalties may increase  
6 General Fund revenue in fiscal year 1992-93 and thereafter.'

8 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

10 This amendment repeals the sunset on penalties for  
12 violations of the pesticide laws and repeals the provision of law  
14 requiring that only seed potatoes of a variety that has been  
released to the public may be certified.
