HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1716, L.D. 2401, Bill, "An Act Concerning Technical Changes to the Tax Laws"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 in the 4th and 5th lines (page 1, lines 24 and 25 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "person responsible for the payment of the tax is the subject of" and inserting in its place the following: 'tax collection action is stayed by the'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 in the last line (page 1, line 26 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "proceedings" and inserting in its place the following: 'proceeding'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 35 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 35. Retroactivity. The sections of this Act that amend the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 2903, subsection 1 take effect retroactively to April 1, 1989.'

This amendment makes technical changes to accomplish the intent of the Joint Standing Committee on Taxation.
