Amend the bill by inserting after section 18 the following:

'Sec. 19. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§6, ¶B, as amended by PL 1989, c. 878, Pt. A, §105, is further amended to read:

B. To patients of hospitals licensed by the State for the care of human beings and other institutions licensed by the State for the hospitalization or nursing care of human beings, or institutions, agencies, hospitals, boarding homes and boarding houses licensed by the Department of Human Services under Title 22, Subtitle 6, and Title 22, section 1781; and

Sec. 20. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§6, ¶C, as repealed and replaced 30 by PL 1979, c. 513, §2, is amended to read:

> C. By hospitals, schools, long-term care facilities, food contractors and restaurants to incorporated nonprofit area agencies on aging for the purpose of providing meals to the elderly,; and

Sec. 21. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§6, ¶D is enacted to read:

40 D. To residents of incorporated nonprofit church-affiliated 40 congregate housing facilities for the elderly in which at 1east 75% of the units are available for leasing to eligible 42 lower-income residents.'
