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Further amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated "<u>\$12104.</u>" in subsection 1 in the last paragraph in the last line (page 7, line 25 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "commencing professional education"

Further amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated "<u>\$12104.</u>" in subsection 5 in paragraph A in subparagraph (2) in 8 the 3rd line (page 8, line 20 in L.D.) by inserting after the 10 following: "area" the following: ', any physician practicing in an underserved specialty or any physician'

Further amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated "<u>§12104.</u>" in subsection 5 in paragraph A in subparagraph (4) in 14 the 5th and 6th lines (page 8, lines 35 and 36 in L.D.) by "<u>for each year in which the</u> striking out the following: 16 physician primarily provides medical" and inserting in its place the following: 'as a physician practicing in an underserved 18 specialty or as a physician providing' 20

Further amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated "<u>§12104.</u>" in subsection 5 by striking out all of paragraph C 22 (page 8, lines 46 to 49 and page 9, lines 1 and 2 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 24

 - (1) The number of Medicaid patients served by the loan recipient and the percentage of the loan recipient's overall service provided to Medicaid patients;
- (2) The number of instances in which a loan recipient accepted a Medicare assignment and the number of and basis for any rejections during the period of the report; and

40 (3) The amount of time devoted by the loan recipient to practice in a public health clinic during the period of the report.

The Department of Human Services, Office of Rural Health and 44 the Finance Authority of Maine shall determine whether the level of service provided by the loan recipient to Medicaid 46 and Medicare patients and in public health clinics was reasonable, If the Office of Rural Health and the Finance 48 Authority of Maine determine that the level of service

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provided was not reasonable or if the loan recipient fails to provide the report by the date required, the loan recipient is not entitled to any loan forgiveness or interest rate reduction under this section for the year of the report.'

Further amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated "**\$12106**" in subsection 2 in the first paragraph in the last line 8 (page 10, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "20" and inserting in its place the following: 10 '21'

Further amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated 12 "<u>\$12106.</u>" in subsection 2 in paragraph A by striking out all of subparagraph (6) (page 10, lines 31 to 33 in L.D.) and inserting 14 in its place the following:

> (6) One must be a representative of a nonprofit hospital medical services organization;

Further amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated "<u>§12106.</u>" in subsection 2 in paragraph E in the first line (page 11, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Five" and '<u>Six</u>' inserting in its place the following:

Further amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated "<u>§12106.</u>" in subsection 2 in paragraph E in subparagraph (4) in 26 the last line (page 11, line 27 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and" 28

Further amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated 30 "<u>§12106.</u>" in subsection 2 in paragraph E in subparagraph (5) in the last line (page 11, line 31 in L.D.) by striking out the 32 place "education." and inserting in its following: the 34 following: 'education; and'

Further amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated 36 "<u>\$12106.</u>" in subsection 2 in paragraph E by inserting after subparagraph (5) the following: 38

'(6) A representative of a major teaching hospital in 40 the State.'

Further amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated "S12107." by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 11, lines 42 to 50 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'The authority shall establish rules necessary to implement this chapter. The Commissioner of Human Services shall develop 48 rules for determining health professional shortage areas for the 50 practice of primary health care medicine and dentistry, for

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determining the reasonableness of the service provided by loan2recipients to Medicaid and Medicare patients and participation by
loan recipients in public health clinics, for determining4underserved groups and for determining underserved specialties.
The Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources shall6develop rules for the determination of insufficient veterinary
services. The rules authorized by this section must be adopted8in accordance with Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II.'

10 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following: 12

'FISCAL NOTE

The changes proposed in the medical education programs administered by the Finance Authority of Maine will allow greater flexibility to the authority to operate these programs within existing resources. The authority can absorb any additional program administration costs and the costs associated with new loan forgiveness and interest rate reduction provisions, as well as the costs of the request for proposals process and rulemaking within existing resources.

24 The Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources will incur some minor additional administrative costs to develop rules 26 for the determination of inadequate veterinary services. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted 28 resources.

 The Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional administrative costs to develop rules to determine
health professional shortage areas and to make determinations, with the Finance Authority of Maine, on new loan forgiveness and
interest rate reduction provisions. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

40 This amendment replaces the definition of "Maine resident," adds a definition of "underserved specialty" and makes several modifications to the loan agreement provisions of the Health 42 Professions Loan Program established in the bill and includes a requirement that loan recipients establish proof of reasonable 44 service to Medicaid patients, Medicare patients and public health clinics as a condition of loan forgiveness or interest rate 46 reduction. The amendment adds a representative of a major 48 teaching hospital in the State to the Advisory Committee on Medical Education. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the 50 bill.
