10	decide that another person from that district would be better qualified. The county commissioner shall serve as
12	nonvoting moderator for that district caucus. Nominations
14	must be received from the floor. The nominee receiving the most votes is approved as a budget advisory committee member except that, in 1992, each caucus shall elect 3 members.
16	The names of those elected by the caucus must be recorded and forwarded to the county commissioners.
