12 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1730, L.D. 2421, Bill, "An 14 Act to Make Allocations from Maine Turnpike Authority Funds for the Maine Turnpike Authority for the Fiscal Year Ending December 16 31, 1993"

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18 Amend the bill in section 4 in the last line (page 2, line 50 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "1993-94" the following: 'and the Department of Public Safety with an amount not less than the State's actual costs associated with the patrol 22 services of the State Police for the corresponding fiscal year'

24 Further amend the bill by inserting after section 4 the following:

'Sec. 5. Conversion to state fiscal year. No later than January 5, 1993, the Maine Turnpike Authority shall conduct a feasibility study and report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over transportation matters concerning adjusting the Maine Turnpike Authority's fiscal year for accounting and budgetary reporting purposes from the current calendar year to coincide with the state fiscal year.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires the Maine Turnpike Authority to 40 provide to the Department of Public Safety an amount not less than the State's costs associated with the patrol services of the 42 State Police. This amendment also requires the Maine Turnpike Authority to conduct a feasibility study and report to the Joint 44 Standing Committee on Transportation concerning converting their fiscal year to coincide with the State's fiscal year.
