An Act to Authorize Construction on a Wharf in Long Lake at Naples.

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(AFTER DEADLINE)

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	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

22	STATEMENT OF FACT
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24	This bill removes the height restrictions on a wharf in Long
-	Lake in Naples. This will allow the owners of the Songo River
26	Queen to construct a structure on the wharf. The bill requires
20	local and state approval and permits before the structure may be
28	constructed. The bill also removes authorization for the
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	construction if it is not completed by May 1, 1993.

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
