COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 962, L.D. 2434, Bill, "An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$18,500,000 for Water Pollution Control Facilities Construction"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$12,000,000 for Water Pollution Control Facilities Construction'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in the 5th line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$18,500,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$12,000,000'

Further amend the bill in section 6 under the part designated "DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION" by striking out all of the 2nd to 5th lines (page 2, lines 12 to 17 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

'Small community and overboard discharge programs	2,000,000

Further amend the bill in section 10 in the question in the first line (page 3, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$18,500,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$12,000,000'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

The estimated cost of sending this bond issue out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda

## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 962, L.D. 2434

2 enacted during the Second Regular Session of the 115th  
Legislature. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one  
4 to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional  
referendum costs an additional \$7,000.

6 If approved by the voters, the total cost of this bond issue  
is estimated to be \$15,696,000 with principal payments of  
8 \$12,000,000 and interest payments of approximately \$3,696,000.'
