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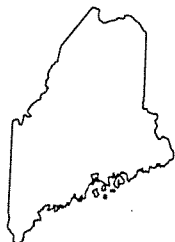

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**Resolve, for Laying of the County Taxes and Authorizing Expenditures  
of York County for the Year 1992.**

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(EMERGENCY)



2 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the  
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after  
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

6 **Whereas,** York County has certain expenses and liabilities  
that must be met as they become due; and

8  
10 **Whereas,** it is necessary that the taxes for the year 1992  
be immediately assessed in order to provide the required revenue  
for the county; and

12 **Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts  
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of  
14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately  
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and  
16 safety; now, therefore, be it

18 **Sec. 1. York County; taxes apportioned. Resolved:** That the  
following sum is granted as a tax on York County to be  
20 apportioned, assessed, collected and applied to the purposes of  
paying debts and necessary expenses of the county as authorized  
22 in this resolve, and for other purposes of law, for the calendar  
year 1992:

32 **Sec. 2. General Fund expenditures authorized. Resolved:** That the  
following sums, based on the county budget filed in the office of  
the Secretary of State, are authorized as General Fund

36 contractual services, commodities and capital expenditures for  
each account in the county budget:
