Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 4 Whereas, it has become necessary to revise the salaries of certain county officials; and 6 8 Whereas, it is desired to have these revisions retroactive to January 1, 1992; and 10 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 12 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately 14 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, 16 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 18 30-A MRSA §2, sub-§1, as repealed and replaced by PL 1991, 20 c. 541, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place: 22 1. County officers salaries. Notwithstanding other sections of this chapter, counties that are not required to obtain legislative approval of their budgets under section 702 24 are not required to obtain legislative approval of the salaries 26 of county officers under this section. The county commissioners, treasurers, sheriffs, judges of probate, registers of probate and registers of deeds in those counties whose budgets require 28 legislative approval under section 702 are entitled to receive in weekly, biweekly or monthly payments annual salaries from the 30 county treasury as follows: 32 1991 <u> 1992</u> 34 A.
