SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1775,
L.D. 2457, Bill, "An Act to Delay the Workers' Compensation Rate
Increase"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 1 the
following:

'Sec. 2. Resolve 1991, c. 59, §1-A is enacted to read:

1-A. Rate increases. The commission shall also consider
the implications of any pending or potential workers'
compensation rate increase and shall make recommendations
designated to mitigate any pending or potential rate increase
retroactive to May 1, 1992.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires the Blue Ribbon Commission to
examine alternatives to the workers' compensation system
established by Resolve 1991, chapter 59, to consider and
recommend actions necessary to mitigate any potential rate
increase retroactive to May 1, 1992.
