## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 115TH LEGISLATURE THIRD SPECIAL SESSION

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HOUSE AMENDMENT "<sup>'</sup>H" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1783, L.D. 2464, Bill, "An Act to Reform the Workers' Compensation Act and Workers' Compensation Insurance Laws"

Amend the amendment on page 4 by striking out all of the 18 first indented paragraph (page 4, lines 16 to 21 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill in Part A in section 8 in that part 22 designated "<u>\$211.</u>" by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 37, lines 8 to 13 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the 24 following:

26 'Effective January 1, 1993, the maximum weekly benefit payable under section 212, 213 or 215 is \$441. Beginning on July
28 1, 1993, the maximum benefit level must be adjusted annually utilizing the state average weekly wage as determined by the
30 Bureau of Employment Security so that it continues to bear the same percentage relationship to the state average weekly wage as
32 it did on January 1, 1993.' '

## FISCAL NOTE

This amendment may reduce the amount of savings resulting 38 from the bill's changes to workers' compensation benefits. The effect on the estimated savings to the State and local units of 40 government as employers can not be estimated at this time.

This amendment requires that the maximum benefit level be adjusted annually so that it continues to bear the same relationship to the state average weekly wage as it did on January 1, 1993.
