22	' <u>An employer may not hire one or more permanent replacement</u> workers to take the place of an injured employee while the employer has an obligation to reinstate that employee under this
24	subsection.'
26	STATEMENT OF FACT

30	This amendment ensures that an employer will be able to reinstate an injured employee to the employee's former job for as long as the employer has the obligation under the law to
32	reinstate that employee. It accomplishes this by prohibiting use of permanent replacement workers to fill the employee's job
34	during the period of the employer's obligation.
