HOUSE AMENDMENT " $\not F$ " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1783, L.D. 2464, Bill, "An Act to Reform the Workers' Compensation Act and Workers' Compensation Insurance Laws"

Amend the amendment on page 7 in the 4th indented paragraph in subsection 1 by striking out all of the last sentence (page 7, lines 30 to 34 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following sentence: 'An injured employee whose date of injury is prior to January 1, 1993 may receive permanent impairment benefits under former Title 39, sections 56, 56-A and 56-B as those sections were in effect at the time of the employee's injury.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment may reduce the amount of savings resulting 30 from the bill's changes to workers' compensation benefits. The effect on the estimated savings to the State and local units of 32 government as employers can not be estimated at this time.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allows a worker injured before January 1, 38 1993 who had the expectation of receiving benefits for permanent impairment to still receive those workers' compensation permanent 40 impairment benefits.
