HOUSE AMENDMENT "G" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1783,  
L.D. 2464, Bill, "An Act to Reform the Workers' Compensation Act  
and Workers' Compensation Insurance Laws"

Amend the amendment on page 6 in the 3rd indented paragraph  
in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 6, lines 19 and 20 in amendment)  
by striking out the following: "each party is responsible for  
the payment of the party's own" and inserting in its place the  
following: 'the employer is liable for payment of a prevailing  
employee's'

**FISCAL NOTE**

This amendment may reduce the amount of savings resulting  
from the bill's changes to the workers' compensation system. The  
effect on the estimated savings to the State and local units of  
government as employers can not be estimated at this time.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment requires that an employer is liable for the  
costs and attorney's fees of a prevailing employee.
