SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1783,  
L.D. 2464, Bill, "An Act to Reform the Workers' Compensation Act  
and Workers' Compensation Insurance Laws"

Amend the amendment on page 2 by striking out all of the 5th  
to 7th paragraphs (page 2, lines 23 to 39 in amendment) and  
inserting in their place the following:

'Further amend the bill in Part A in section 8 in that part  
designated "~~§152.~~" in subsection 4 in the last 2 lines (page 20,  
lines 27 and 28 in L.D.) by striking out all of the last sentence.


Further amend the bill in Part A in section 8 in that part  
designated "~~§152.~~" by striking out all of subsection 6.

Further amend the bill in Part A in section 8 in that part  
designated "~~§152.~~" by renumbering the subsections to read  
consecutively.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment deletes language declassifying positions not  
yet authorized and allows the Workers' Compensation Board to  
establish the personnel structure necessary to perform the  
functions of the board.
