HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 1783, L.D. 2464, Bill, "An Act to Reform the Workers' Compensation Act and Workers' Compensation Insurance Laws"

Amend the bill in Part A in section 8 in that part designated "§201." in subsection 4 in the last line (page 26, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "manner." the following: 'This subsection does not apply if the employee is a firefighter at the time of the work injury.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment may reduce the amount of savings resulting from the bill's changes to workers' compensation benefits. The effect on the estimated savings to the State and local units of government as employers can not be estimated at this time.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment exempts a firefighter from the preexisting condition test in Title 39-A, section 201, subsection 4 as enacted in the bill.
