HOUSE AMENDMENT "O" to H.P. 1783, L.D. 2464, Bill, "An Act to Reform the Workers' Compensation Act and Workers' Compensation Insurance Laws"

Amend the bill in Part A in that section designated "§318." in the 2nd paragraph in the first line (page 64, line 34 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "The hearing officer," and inserting in its place the following: 'A hearing officer other than the hearing officer who rendered a decision pursuant to the first paragraph.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allows a party to have that party's decision reviewed by a hearing officer different from the one who rendered the original decision.
