SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1783, L.D. 2464, Bill, "An Act to Reform the Workers' Compensation Act and Workers' Compensation Insurance Laws"

Amend the bill in Part A in section 8 by striking out all of that part designated "§223." (page 51, line 52 and page 52, lines 2 to 21 in L.D.)


FISCAL NOTE

This amendment may reduce the amount of savings resulting from the bill's changes to workers' compensation benefits. The effect on the estimated savings to the State and local units of government as employers can not be estimated at this time.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment eliminates the presumption that an injured employee who receives retirement benefits, including Social Security old-age benefits, does not have a loss of earnings or loss of earning capacity as a result of a work injury or disease.
