HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 21, "Joint Order Adopting the 115th Joint Rules"

Amend the Joint Order in Joint Rule 35-A by striking out all of subsection 1.

Further amend the Joint Order in Joint Rule 35-A in subsection 3 in the first line by striking out the following: "any other"

Further amend the Joint Order in Joint Rule 35-A by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes the requirement of a 2/3 vote for any legislation requesting the calling of a United States Constitutional Convention. The amendment also makes other technical changes to reflect this removal.
