COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 26, L.D. 19, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Holding of Juveniles in the Androscoggin County Jail"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph B-2 in the first 2 lines (page 1, lines 26 and 27 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~until--September--30,--1993,~~" and inserting in its place the following: 'until September-30 December 31, 1993 1995,'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Corrections will continue to avoid the General Fund costs associated with detaining at the Maine Youth Center the juveniles that are detained at the Androscoggin County Jail. The department does receive additional General Fund revenue from the counties when juveniles are detained at the Maine Youth Center. The amount of the costs that will be avoided and the loss of General Fund revenue to offset these costs through December 31, 1995 can not be determined at this time.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

Currently, the law allows juveniles to be housed in the Androscoggin County Jail until September 30, 1993. The bill removes the deadline of September 30, 1993. This amendment sets a new deadline of December 31, 1995.
