SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 19, L.D. 21, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Lounge License Provisions"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 by inserting at the end a new blocked paragraph to read:

'Notwithstanding this subsection, in a municipality that has adopted an ordinance that has been approved by the voters at referendum, a minor may remain on the premises after 8:00 p.m.'

This amendment gives the municipality the option to let minors remain in lounges after 8:00 p.m.
