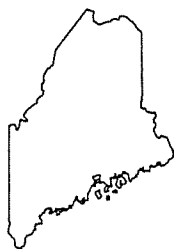

An Act to Amend the Lounge License Provisions.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1065, sub-§4, as repealed and replaced by
4 PL 1987, c. 342, §90, is amended to read:

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4. Minors not allowed on premises. Minors are not permitted
to remain on the premises after 8:00 p.m. except when:

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A. The minor is accompanied by a parent, legal guardian or
custodian as defined in Title 22, section 4002; or

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B. The licensee does not permit consumption of liquor on
the premises for a specific period of time or event.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill allows minors to remain in a lounge until 8:00
p.m. even though the minor is not accompanied by a parent, legal
guardian or custodian.

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
