An Act to Prohibit People from Riding in the Back of Open Pickup Trucks.

12	A. "Pickup truck" means a vehicle designed or used principally for carrying things other than passengers and includes a vehicle to which has been added a cabinet box,
14	<u>platform, rack or other equipment for the purpose of carrying materials other than passengers or their effects.</u>

18	2. Passengers to be secured. Any passenger in or on any portion of a pickup truck that is not enclosed or that is not
	designed by the vehicle's manufacturer for passenger occupancy
20	must be seated and properly secured.
22	3. Rules. The Chief of the State Police shall adopt rules
24	governing the proper securement of passengers riding in or on any portion of a pickup truck that is not enclosed or that is not

	4. Warnings. Any operator of a pickup truck stopped for a
