Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, this Act makes changes in survivor benefits under the Maine State Retirement System that are vital to the survivors of members of the system who may die before 90 days after the adjournment of this Legislature; and

10 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 12 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 14 safety; now, therefore,

16 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. P&SL 1991, c. 122, §1 is amended to read:

Sec. 1. Maine State Retirement System death benefits to surviving 20spouses. Notwithstanding Public Law 1991, chapter 469, а qualifying member of the Maine State Retirement System who was 22 receiving a disability retirement benefit on or after October 9, 1991 due-to-a terminal condition-as-defined in the Maine Revised 24 Statutes,-Title-18-A,- section -5-701-and who dies as a result of 26 that terminal disabling condition before July 1, 1993 is deemed to have died after July 1, 1993 for the purposes of calculating and awarding benefits to a surviving spouse, including 28 a surviving spouse of a qualifying member who dies before completing the age and service requirements 30 for service retirement, as provided pursuant to Public Law 1991, chapter 469.

 - Sec. 2. Retroactivity. This Act applies retroactively to April 10, 1992.

- 36 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill amends the law to clarify the eligibility of a 44 surviving spouse to death benefits under the Maine State Retirement System when the member was receiving a disability 46 retirement benefit and dies as a result of that disabling condition.
